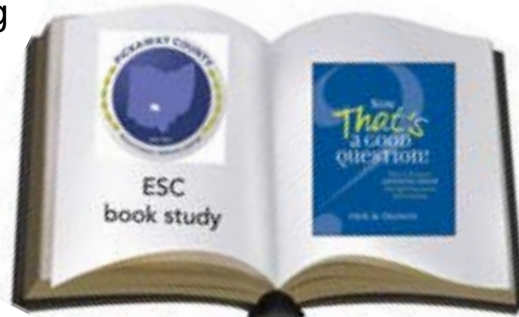


## Book study professional development

### *Now That's a Good Question: How to Promote Cognitive Rigor Through Classroom Questioning*

**WHO?** The Pickaway County ESC is offering a hybrid book study of *Now That's a Good Question* this winter with ESC consultant Jill Riddle.



**WHAT?** Participants will read, study and discuss the text about the instructional strategy of questioning to deepen student thinking, understanding and application of knowledge. They will participate in three in-person classes, using the text and appropriate talking points to guide the discussion; they will consider the professional resource in relation to their classroom practices; and they will complete monthly posts (checkpoints) via e-mail to the instructor.
