This book study has a rolling enrollment but participants must complete assignments by June 1.

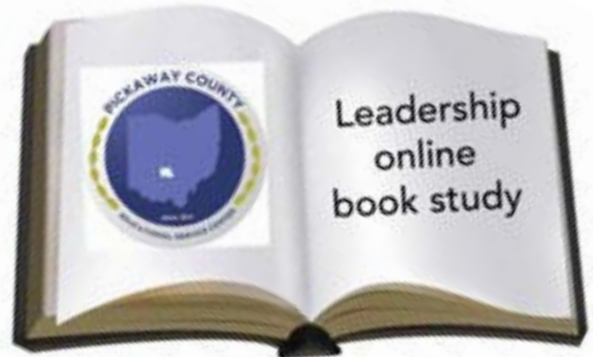
