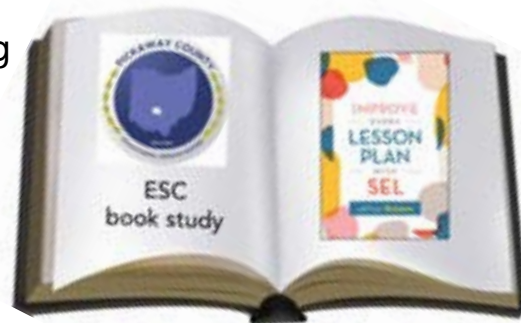


Online Leadership Book Study

WHAT?

This class will show teachers how to merge social and emotional learning skills in every aspect of a lesson plan without adding a separate SEL curriculum. All student populations — gender, race, ethnicity, disabilities, social and economically disadvantaged, migrant and homeless groups — deserve a learning environment that will close inequities in achievement, opportunity and learning.

This class is based on the work of teacher and author Jeffrey Benson and his book *Improve Every Lesson Plan with SEL*, which will guide teachers on incorporating SEL strategies into developed lesson plans and immediately boost student motivation and achievement. This information will also better prepare teachers to address OTES 2.0 domains of Classroom Climate and Cultural Competency.
